

# Can it be recycled?



These five items aren't quite ready for recycling. Explain or write down what we need to do before we put them in the recycling container.

Potential item	How do we make it recyclable?
A clear plastic water bottle with a blue cap.	Empty the water from the water bottle. Always make sure your recyclables are empty, clean, and dry.
A light blue paper envelope with a small plastic window and a postage stamp.	Separate the plastic window from the paper envelope. You can recycle the paper portion.
A glass jar with a red lid, containing peanut butter.	Wash out all of the remaining peanut butter. Always make sure your recyclables are empty, clean, and dry.
An open cardboard pizza box with a brown paper top and a greasy bottom.	Separate the clean, recyclable top of the pizza box from the greasy, contaminated bottom.
A cardboard box for a toy robot, with a plastic window and a plastic front.	You can recycle the cardboard part of the box if you remove the plastic front of the packaging.
