Discussion Questions

Discuss the video with your child. Here are some ideas for discussion questions. You may also want to use the Recycling Simplified (Grades PreK-5) handout included in the Bonus Learning Resources for ideas. The first page of the handout shows things that can and cannot be recycled, and the second page contains additional tips for you on ways to recycle or reuse common things around the home.



Why do you think we recycle things?

Examples: Recycling means less garbage. It keeps our air and water cleaner. It helps people and animals stay healthy.



What kinds of things can we recycle?

Answer: Paper, cardboard boxes, metal cans, and plastic bottles and jugs



Do you remember the 3 steps to recycling the right way?

Let's go over them together. You and your child can use any wording that communicates the 3 basic steps: **(1)** Know what kinds of things can and can't be recycled. **(2)** Make sure your recyclables are empty, clean, and dry. **(3)** Put recyclables in the container loose, not in plastic bags.
